

INVITATION TO BID GRAVEL BY GRANITE COUNTY

Please be advised that GRANITE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Montana, is now accepting sealed, written bids for up to 10,000 yards of ¾" minus gravel of good quality for customary road use.

Each sealed bid shall state the itemized dollar amount for the product per yard (gravel dollar amount) and a separate itemized dollar amount for delivery of 5,000 yards of gravel to Granite County's shop located in Philipsburg, MT, and a separate itemized dollar amount for delivery of 5,000 yards of gravel to Granite County's shop in Hall, MT. Each sealed bid must be clearly marked "Gravel Bid, April 2024" on the outside of the envelope. The bids will be opened in a public meeting before the Board of Granite County Commissioners at their Courthouse office on Tuesday, April 9, 2024 at 9:25 am. The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, including for quality of product as the County reserves the right to inspect the gravel prior to taking possession.
