

RESOLUTION 2006-7

**A RESOLUTION CREATING THE
FLINT CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Granite County has received a valid petition requesting the creation of a fire service area, to be known as the Flint Creek Fire Service Area; and,

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2006, the Board unanimously adopted a Resolution of Intent to Create the Flint Creek Fire Service Area; and,

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the proposed fire service area within Granite County are shown and described as Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to create fire service areas as provided by Section 7-32-2401, et. seq., MCA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Granite County that it establishes and creates the Flint Creek Fire Service Area and that the boundaries of the Flint Creek Fire Service Area shall be as shown and described on Exhibit A attached hereto; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners will appoint members to a board of trustees to govern and manage the affairs of the Flint Creek Fire Service Area, until elections are held; and,

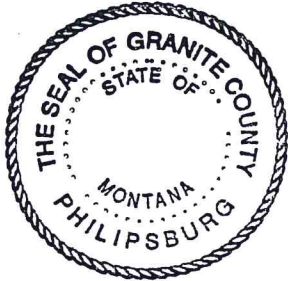
BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that services will be funded by assessments made within the Flint Creek Fire Service Area, that owners of all inhabitable structures or businesses and up to one accessory building per inhabitable structure or business will be assessed for fire protection service, and the annual assessment for such services will be Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for each principal inhabitable structure or business and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for an accessory building. If a principal inhabitable structure or business has more than one accessory building, the only one accessory building shall be annually assessed. An accessory building is any building or structure which is incidental to a principal inhabitable building or business.

FLINT CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA

The area of Granite County, Montana proposed for the Flint Creek Fire Service Area is described as follows:

Township 6N, Range 13W, Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, Township 7N, Range 13W, Sections 18, 19, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, Township 6N, Range 14W, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 27, Township 7N, Range 14W, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 33, 34, 35, 36, Township 8N, Range 14W, Sections 25, 35, 36.

The entire town limits of Philipsburg is included in this description, however, the entire town limits of Philipsburg is excluded from the said Flint Creek Fire Service Area.
