A GRANITE COUNTY RESOLUTION SETTING DAILY INCARCERATION RATE AND DAILY RATE OF CREDIT FOR INCARCERATION FOR YEAR 2025

WHEREAS, Montana law requires, specifically Section 46-18-403, MCA, that the Board of Granite County Commissioners amended establishes the daily incarceration rate and daily rate of credit for incarceration per inmate at the Granite County Jail that is applicable for the calendar year 2024; and,

WHEREAS, current Granite County Sheriff/Coroner, Scott Dunkerson, using reasonable and customary calculation methods, has established the actual costs for incarceration at the Granite County Jail to be \$82.80 per inmate per day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Granite County Commissioners daily incarceration rate and daily rate of credit for incarceration per inmate at the Granite County Jail at \$82.00 per day for the calendar year 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the computation for the said daily rate for the incarceration is equal to the actual cost incurred by the Granite County per day per inmate.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this Resolution shall have an immediate effective date.
