I: Call to Order

III: Conservation Easement

A: Wood Creek Conservation Easement - Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation

Linda Bouck noted this is a conservation easement proposed for 1,120 acres owned by the Bouchee family. The property is located approximately 8 miles southwest of Drummond. The Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation would be the recipient of the easement. The property is used for foraging and calving by elk and other wildlife species. Bouck introduced Nathan Stone, representative for the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.

Nathan Stone gave a brief overview of the project and goals of the conservation easement. He pointed out this is a donation of easement by the landowner and not a purchase of easement. The donation of land is 2 parcels which will be restricted to be sold together in the future along with development limitations.

The Planning Board held a discussion of the conservation easement in question and discussed the Planning Board's role in reviewing conservation easement. The Planning Board was unanimous in approving of the conservation easement and asked that a letter be sent to the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation in support of the project.
